## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- 1. Housing is limited and is given on first come first served basis. Rent payment is covered in the fee structure and is payable on the reporting date.
- 2. YOU are required to carry along ONLY your Beddings and other personal effects. Beds and Mattresses will be provided.
- 3. YOU are required to come with at least 8, 100 page, A4 size writing pads/books and enough pens.
- 4. YOU will be required to buy your own food at the following rates per day depending on your choice:

MEAL	PRICE RANGE (KShs) per day
Breakfast	30 - 150
Lunch	60 - 200
Dinner/Supper	60 – 240

- 5. Those not keen on having their meals at the University cafeteria will have exceptional approval to cook in a shared kitchen. In this case, you will be expected to come with basic cooking items/utensils.
- 6. YOU are required to apply for HELB loan to cover part of your Tuition fees and other university expenses including Hostel, Insurance, Food and Books.
- 7. YOU are required to have a medical insurance cover from any of the following options:
  - a. Proof of full year payment for National Hospital Insurance Fund (NHIF).
  - b. Proof of adequate Medical Insurance cover from a recognized/reputable Insurance Company.
